



AAWC Travel Grant

The Association for the Advancement of Wound Care (AAWC) provides travel grants to offset costs for AAWC members to travel to HVO Wound and Lymphedema project sites.

HVO seeks active or retired physicians, podiatrists, nurses, physical and occupational therapists, and researchers specialized in wound care and lymphedema management to volunteer at project sites in a variety of countries (see website for updated list of active project sites.)

Qualified volunteers are health care professionals involved in providing advanced, evidence-based wound care including edema/lymphedema management and working with wounds in an academic setting, a clinical practice in any setting, wound research, or infection control. Previous clinical or academic teaching experience is preferred but not required. Clinicians must have a current professional license. Assignments are 1 to 2 weeks or longer.

All interested applicants for the AAWC Travel Grant must be members of AAWC and qualify to volunteer with HVO. To apply, send the following (all documents should be in MS Word or PDF format):

- Send a one page letter (MS Word or PDF format) highlighting previous experience and To apply: motivation for seeking travel grant to Kim Rodgers (<u>k.rodgers@hvousaorg</u>). The email subject line should be "AAWC Travel Grant."
 - Complete the on-line <u>HVO Volunteer Application form</u> which includes uploading your current CV.

Completed applications (letter, HVO Volunteer Application form, CV) will be reviewed by the HVO Wound Care steering committee. All recipients must begin their volunteer assignment.
